### **REVISED REPORTING DATE FOR S2 CLASS FOR SCHOOL CALENDAR – 2020**

Reference is made to the revised school calendar issued on 14 December 2020.


The initial school re-opening dates for Senior Two (S2) learners was 31<sup>st</sup> May 2021. However, following the completion of UCE and UACE examinations by S4 and S6 learners respectively, more space has been created in schools to accommodate an extra class while observing the Covid-19 SOPs.

Considering the urgent need for recovery of lost learning time and the negative impact of long absence from school on young adolescents, the Ministry of Education and Sports, in consultation with stakeholders, has brought forward the reporting date for S2 by about two weeks.

Instead of 31<sup>st</sup> May 2021, the S2 learners will now report back to school on to 13<sup>th</sup> May 2021 and break off on 24<sup>th</sup> July 2021. This reporting date does not apply to S2 learners in the schools currently being used by UNEB as examination marking centres. The S2 learners in these schools will report on 8<sup>th</sup> June.
