Manifesto Performance in Bukedi Sub region

Introduction

This regional brief contains statistics of information relating to progress on Sectors of Education, Health, Roads, Electricity, Water, Livelihoods, Parish Development Model and Emyooga in regards to in implementation of the Manifesto Commitments within the Subregion.

EDUCATION SECTOR

Primary Schools

Bukedi sub- region has got 635 Parishes and of these 469 have got Primary Schools while 166 are missing the primary schools. On average the sub-region has a 74% coverage of primary schools. The cumulative statistics are broken down as below;

Secondary Schools

Bukedi sub-region has got 155 lower local Governments including Sub-Counties, town councils and divisions. Of these 85 have got Secondary Schools while 66 don't have these Secondary Schools. On average the sub-region has a 58% coverage of Secondary schools. The cumulative statistics are broken down as below;

Roads

1107.4 Km of roads have been constructed in the sub-region. Various districts have also received road equipment and 361km of the District Urban and Community Access Roads have been worked on and are in good motorable situation.

Water Provision

In Bukedi Sub-region, 627 out of 635 parishes have got 2 water sources and only 8 in Butaleja do not have these water points. The region has got 14 irrigation schemes with the majority of these found in Pallisa District. In the Sub-region, on average access to Rural water is at 72% while access to urban water is at 66%. On average the Sub region has got a 70% access to Safe water.




Budumba Solar powered piped water scheme in Butaleja District, Bukedi Sub-Region

All districts headquarters in the sub-region are connected to the national grid. 102 of the 140 sub-county headquarters are connected to the national grid and 38 of these are not yet connected to the grid.

Judiciary

To improve access to justice in the Sub-region; The Judiciary has constructed a High Court building and completed renovation of the Chief Magistrates Court building in Tororo a Chief Magistrates Court building was also constructed in Budaka District Local Government.

Lands

To improve land administration, The Ministry of Lands Housing and Urban Development procured computers and printers for 40 District Land Boards across the country and Butebo Local Government was one of the beneficiaries. The computers shall facilitate retooling of the DLBS and improve documentation of land records. Plans are underway to scale up the Land information system to the Districts Land Boards to improve efficient and effectiveness in land administration.

Government has produced and issued 80,166 CCOs across the country and some of were beneficiaries in Butaleja District Local Government. To Enhance wealth and job creation programs to sustainably raise citizens' income levels to enable them to afford decent housing. Prototype plans prepared/ reproduced for Butebo.

Livelihood Projects

Government has extended a number of livelihood projects to the Sub-region under the Social Assistance Grant for the Elderly (SAGE), Youth Livelihood programme (YLP) and the Uganda Women Entrepreneurship Programme (UWEP). Within these programmes, 15,048 individuals have benefited from the SAGE, 3514 individuals have benefited from the YLP while 3,928 individuals have benefited from the UWEP. The only limitation is the slow funds coverage rate from the YLP and the UWEP.

EAC trade.

Uganda through the Ministry of East African Community Affairs has undertaken a number of steps to promote the Integration of the EAC member states. This in turn has promoted Uganda's trade potential within the neighboring countries through the One stop border points that are located within the Bukedi Sub-region. The Sub-region has got two major One stop border points of Busia and Malaba. The table below shows the volume of Uganda's exports (informal and Formal) that the country has realized by the year 2023.

Generally, Uganda was able to realize USD 6,789.83m from the volume of exports from the various border across the country. The two border points of Busia and Malaba were able to support exports of up to USD 2,225.4 million which represents 33% of the overall export trade.



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
